Composition:

Essential Oils (Eucalyptus, Peppermint, Carvacrol, Thyme and Camphor) Excipients

Description:

- restores natural movements of the Eucalyptus epithelium and its supports bronchial secretion clearance.
- Peppermint stimulates the respiratory tract and nervous system.
- Carvacrol protect against toxins and fight fungal infections
- Thyme helps to alleviate coughing and other symptoms of acute bronchitis

Indications:

- Relieving respiratory symptoms related to infection.

- Introduction of new birds to an existing herd.
- During litter transfer.

Rate of Inclusion:

Administration via drinking water:

Chicks- 1 ml/ 10 liters of drinking water for 3 days.

Broiler/Layer/Sonali- 1 ml/ 5 liters of drinking water for 3

Administration via spray method

Poultry: 10 ml/ 1 liter water. Horse: 0.5-1 ml/ 1 liter water. Cattle: 10 ml/ 1 liter water.

Wait for 2 days after vaccination then administer during 3

consecutive days, 2 times a day.

Or as directed by the registered veterinarian/ nutritionist.

Shake the bottle well before use.

Contraindication:

No side effect observed in recommended dose.

Withdrawal Period:

Meat- Nil, Egg- Nil.

Storage:

Protected from light, Store in a cool and dry place.

Keep out of the reach of children.
